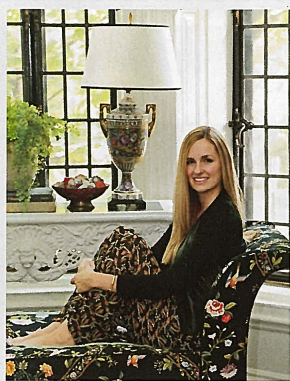

Lamps do more than light up our lives—they add color and character to our rooms. And we all have our favorites. Ten designers show us theirs.

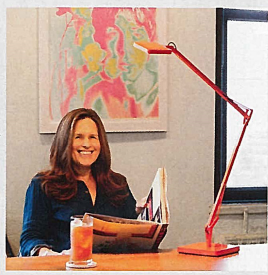

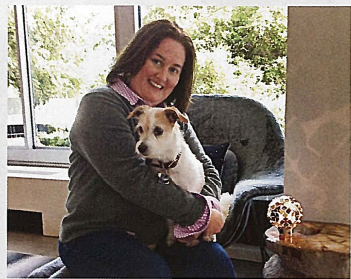
"I'm in love with my new orange lamp from Flos. Such a fun, punchy color—and the articulated design and LED light make it practical too."
