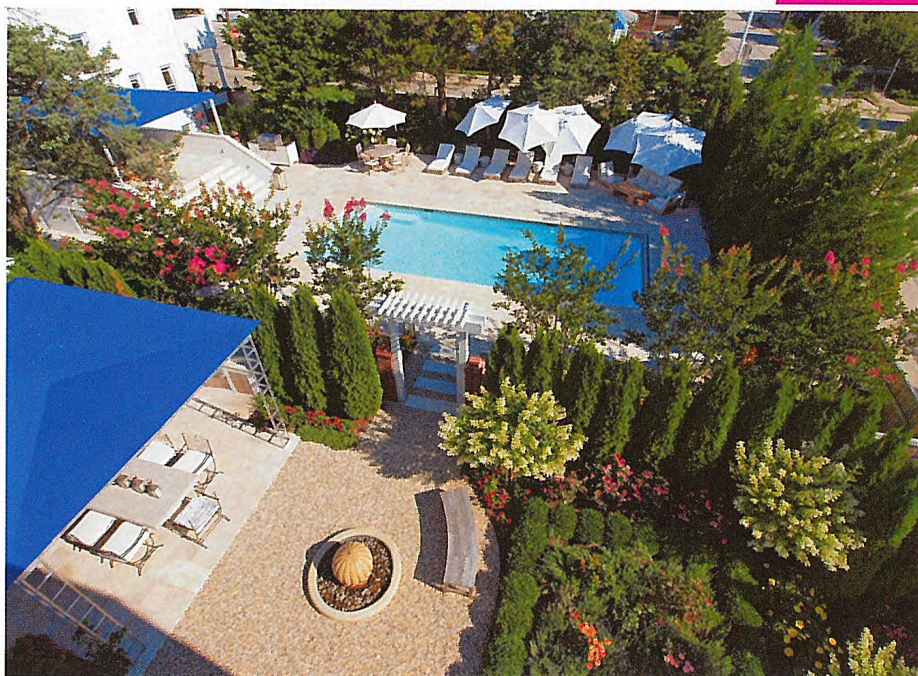
The properties' original home looks out onto an elegant gunite pool masterfully built by Paco Pools & Spas. Surrounding the pool is a sprawling limestone patio. It's clean, geometric lines

and neutral tones are a perfect complement to the bold, vibrant colors and textures of the nearby planting beds laden with summer flowering tropical.

The interior of the new home, superbly designed by Pierce Allen Architects, flows seamlessly into the refined rear yard. A limestone patio covered by a canvas pavilion houses a monolithic granite table. Alfresco dining couldn't get any better in this outdoor space.
